

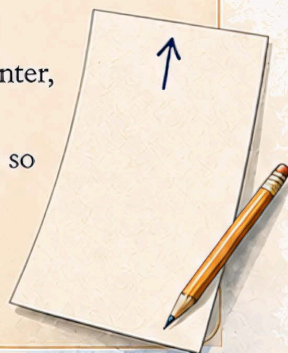
How to Print Your Test Pages

A quick test now can save cardstock, ink, and time before printing the full game.



NEW TO MANUAL DOUBLE-SIDED PRINTING?

If you're unfamiliar with manual double-sided printing on your printer, use a sheet of plain paper first. Draw an arrow near the top edge so you can learn the correct paper orientation before printing on cardstock.



PRINTING THE TEST PAGES

- 1 Print Test Page 1.**
Then reinsert the cardstock and print **Test Page 2** on the back.
- 2** Hold the finished sheet up to a light or window to check the front/back alignment.
Perfect alignment isn't necessary—extra margin is built into the game.
- 3** Make sure you're happy with the colors and print quality before printing the full game.



TIP

Not happy with the colors?

If they look dull or muddy, search online for your printer model's recommended print settings. Many printers can produce better results with a few simple adjustments.
